Radio codes have been established to shorten transmission, give concise information, and improve department radio communication. It is important for all personnel to use these codes when transmitting to borough, unit, etc. All personnel will not deviate from using proper radio procedure and will transmit all messages in a professional manner. The current radio codes are as follows:

- 10-1 Reporting in service
- 10-2 Reporting out of service
- 10-3 Request radio test
- 10-4 Acknowledge message received
- 10-5 Repeat message - Not understood
- 10-6 Reception poor - Change location
- 10-7 Contact \_\_\_\_\_ by phone immediately
- 10-8 Return to your office immediately
- 10-9 Stop transmitting
- 10-10 Have priority message to transmit
- 10-11 Change channels
- 10-12 Continue normal radio operations
- 10-13 Are there any messages for me?
- 10-14 What is your location?
- 10-20 Serious emergency - All units stop
